Volunteer Positions / Placement	Role:	Remarks
Route Marshals / Combers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be stationed along the route. Guide people along the route and cheer them on. Marshals to clear their assigned route area of twigs and branches. Marshals will double up as route combers when the event ends. Ensure race route and event space is kept clean and be swept of litter after the event. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. Marshals to report at 6.45am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
Logistics Assistants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist in delivery of logistics. Stock-take of the logistics after the event (liaise with respective departments). Provide logistics assistance to any department when required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. The team would have to rotate and ensure that at least one of them is present to receive goods from the sponsors on specified dates and times. Dates and times will only be confirmed later.
Crowd Controllers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Crowd management during the warm-up exercise, start off and when participants return to event space. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 7am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day. Guys preferred for this role.
Balloon Station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fill up balloons using the helium tank. Distribute balloons to the participants. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.30am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
Drinks Station	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To be stationed at designated locations to hand out drinks to participants. Ensure drinks are prepared (chilled). Control the queues at drink collection points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.00am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 5 to 6 hours on Race Day.





Sales of Merchandise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To handle the sale of Merchandise. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.15am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
Stage Assistants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure the smooth flow of the programme. Ensure podium, microphone and air horn are ready at the start point. Providing cues for performers. Managing performers onsite. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.15am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 5 to 6 hours on Race Day.
Information / Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To handle queries To handle onsite registration (if required) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.30am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
Goodie Bag Packers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Packing goodie bags prior to the day of event. Ensure all items are packed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report on specified day prior to the Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours. 20 of these volunteers will be distributors on Race day.
Goodie Bag Distributors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Handle the distribution of goodie bags to participants after the race. Control the queue at the Goodie Bag Distribution Point. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.30am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
Photographers and Videographers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist in taking photos and videos of the event on the event day. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required to attend a 2-hr training session in September. Required to read the Volunteer Guide prior to Race Day. To report at 6.30am on Race Day. Duration of duty – 4 to 5 hours on Race Day.
